Here is our charming waitress receiving a \$200.00 check from our club for her service this year.



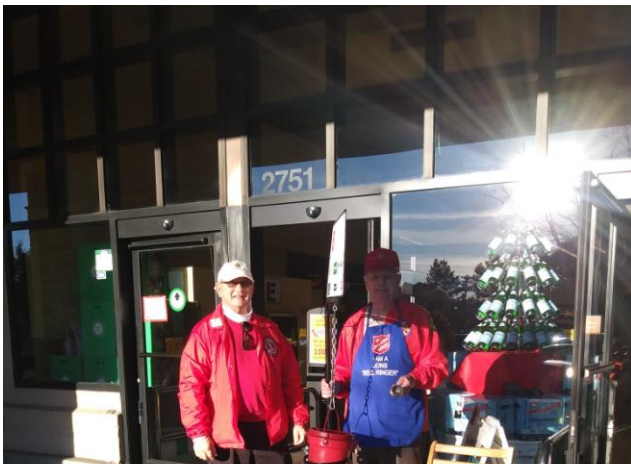
Our district governor has one of the houses with Christmas decorations that people from all over the north bay visit. I visited last night and thought that maybe others that are lions should know about this.
