Well, another month has passed by us very quickly. Believe it or not, we're heading into the Holiday Season. It's time to get ready for large meals, lots of sweet things to eat & time to gain a few pounds. Denice & I have already finished our Christmas shopping. Online ordering is great.

A lot has happened over the past 30 days. Many of our clubs have been working hard on fire relief in their areas. So far we've put out from grant money from LCIF & the CLF, over \$11,000 of relief efforts with more donations to go out. Some clubs are still working on relief efforts. We also received \$4,500 of fire relief funds from clubs in the district. I want to thank every club that has worked on the relief effort & those that donated to the fire relief fund. This is an amazing District of Lions who have always been ready to serve their communities, no matter the need.

We have an online Cabinet meeting coming up on Sat. Nov. 14th, starting @ 8.30 am. We have some interesting topics to discuss, the Youth Protection Policy, changes to the District Constitution & By Laws & Budget for 2021-2022. There will be open discussion on all 3 of these topics. We're working on them early so that we can have them fine-tuned by the February 2021 Cabinet meeting. Cabinet Secretary Cyndi emailed a package out to everyone early in the week of October 26th.

Lions International & MD4 will start taking a harder stance on clubs that are behind in dues. If you don't have your current dues paid up by Dec. 31, 2020 - January 2021 your club will be put on financial suspension. If those dues aren't paid by Mar. 1st, 2021 your charter will be put into 'status quo' & ready for your charter to be cancelled. Please, please, pay your dues. I don't want to see any club suspended or cancelled. If your club is having an administrative finance problem, please let Cab. Sec. Cyndi know. She will help you arrange a payment plan with LCIF & MD4. DETAILED INFO/DATES FROM LCI ARE OUTLINED ON THE FINAL PAGE OF THIS NEWSLETTER.

I was fortunate to visit 3 clubs on Oct. 27th/28th. It was fun & felt great to finally have a live meeting in the district. I know many of the clubs are still unable to meet, so we have put off any further visitations until the 1st of the year. If I can I'll still visit every club in the district.



NEXT CABINET MEETING – SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 27, 2021 (We hope to be able to meet in person, but that all depends on the COVID-19 status)

FROM LIONS INTERNATIONAL.

Because of these challenging times during the Covid-19 pandemic, a resolution was approved in May, stating that no clubs will be suspended/cancelled through Dec. 31,2020 for late payment of dues. We want to ensure everyone is aware of important dates/action items that will impact clubs, so we can all work together to support them during this difficult time.

OCT. 25, 2020 – District teams will be advised on clubs w/unpaid balances within suspension parameters.

OCT, NOV, & DEC statements will include suspension warnings informing clubs of past-due status.

JAN.1, 2021 – Clubs will be placed on Financial Suspension if balances over 120 days are in excess of US\$ 20/member or over \$1,000. Clubs released from FS can expect to be billed for dues Jan-June 2021.

MAR 1, 2021 – Clubs previously suspended will automatically be cancelled if their balance is not paid in full.

MAR-JUNE 2021 – Cancelled clubs may be reactivated to 'Active Status' upon receipt of their payment & approval from the District Governor.

MAY 8, 2021 – The suspension cycle will again review clubs for balances unpaid over 120 days, w/cancellation following on Jun, 20th, if payment has not been received.

DG RECAPS will be mailed regularly each month. District team should review the report & communicate w/clubs to encourage payment prior to the end of this calendar year.

We will be sending the list of clubs on suspension to our District team & Global Action Team leadership each month to support the districts.
